

Model APA Title Page

Based on APA Publication Manual, 6th ed., 2010.

The header contains a page number and the running head, a shortened version of the full title (50 characters or less in all caps). On the title page only, include the words "Running head:". All other pages' headers will contain only the running head flush left and page numbers flush right. See APA 8.03.

Center the title, author's name(s) and institution(s) in the upper half of the page. All lines should be double-spaced and text should be plain 12-point Times New Roman (no bold, underline, or italics). Titles should be no longer than 12 words, summarize the main topic, and indicate the relationship between the variables under consideration. See APA 2.01.

Often, the author note is optional for student essays. Ask your instructor.

The author note identifies authors' departments and institutional affiliations (paragraph 1). It should indicate any changes in affiliation (para. 2), acknowledge financial support (para.3), and provide contact information (para. 4). See APA 2.03.
